Teacher: Ron & Julie Parrish **Description:** Includes all the visual praise and worship instruments needed for ministry practice. The focus of this class will be to train and equip students to praise and worship the Lord by using their talents to glorify Him. We'll briefly lay a Biblical foundation for each art form and then practice. They'll be using visuals and expressive arts to portray Christian songs, psalms, poems, or God's Word.
